The Cranston Residents Association (CRA) is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to enhancing community life in Cranston. Through the management of Century Hall, a seven-acre outdoor park, and key community landmarks—including the Art Park, Windmill site, decorative corners, and Cranston entry features—the CRA creates vibrant spaces for residents to connect and thrive.

CRA programs, events, and initiatives are made possible through resident support and valued community partnerships. Sponsors play a key role in helping us deliver inclusive programming, maintain shared spaces, and strengthen connections across the community.

Our Mission

The CRA's mission is to enhance the quality of life for Cranston residents by fostering community connection through accessible amenities, well-maintained facilities, and inclusive events and programs, delivered in a financially responsible manner.

Event Sponsorship

There are many ways to be involved as an event sponsor with the CRA. We host a wide variety of events, programs, markets, and activities for all age groups throughout the year. Event sponsorships allow us to create fun, memorable experiences for Cranston residents while supporting and showcasing local businesses by connecting them directly with our community. Partnership Engagement Options

Sponsors have the opportunity to engage directly with event attendees through a variety of customizable options, including on-site booth or table space (where applicable), banner or other physical branding at the event, and interactive experiences such as product sampling, giveaways, or service-based activations.

Marketing & Recognition

Event sponsors receive comprehensive recognition through logo placement across CRA marketing channels, including the website, social media, posters, and e-newsletters, along with mentions in event promotions and on-site recognition through signage and event announcements.

Support types and Pricing

The CRA offers flexible sponsorship options, including both monetary and in-kind support.

- **Annual Partnership Agreement:** Opportunities are available for sponsors supporting multiple events every year, with flexible pricing based on the event and level of participation.
- **Single-event sponsorships:** Start at \$300, with pricing adjusted based on event size and scope.
- **In-kind sponsorship:** Support CRA events through the donation of goods, services, or expertise in place of, or in addition to, monetary contributions. This may include items such as food and beverages, prizes, event supplies, entertainment and more.

Event Overview

Our events are primarily designed to serve Cranston residents. While non-residents are welcome to attend, promotion is generally directed to Cranston residents. Select signature events, such as the Stampede Breakfast are open to all.

Our fiscal year runs from April 1 to March 31, with Annual Partnership Agreements starting in April.

Youth Pathways Programs

Support Cranston youth by giving them space to grow and succeed—whether it's a vendor table at our seasonal Farmers' Markets or a Summer Camp internship. These opportunities help young people gain entrepreneurial and leadership experience while connecting with the community, with sponsors recognized through marketing channels, event promotions, and on-site visibility.

Youth Entrepreneur Farmers Market Tables

Support a young entrepreneur by sponsoring a youth vendor table at one of our seasonal Markets (Summer or Winter). Market sponsorship helps cover the cost of a vendor booth, giving youth vendors the opportunity to showcase and sell their products without the vendor cost while gaining valuable entrepreneurial experience. **This sponsorship includes a vendor booth at the market(s), offering direct interaction with the community.**

Sponsorship pricing varies based on the event and type of support, and we're happy to discuss options that best suit each partnership. Cranston Summer Camp Internship Program

Sponsor a youth honorarium—interns receive an honorarium of \$750—and help empower the next generation of community leaders. Youth applicants are selected for one of eight internship positions, where they receive hands-on mentorship from our experienced team while developing valuable leadership skills through supporting our Day Camp programs. This internship represents the second level of our Leaders in Training program and directly supports our goal of building strong, capable leaders within the Cranston community.


Rink Board Advertising
